

Come and See

Here are are some ways to see where you might find yourself in the story.

1. Re-read the John 2:1-11 off the bulletin or your Bible.
 - Which character do you relate to the most? Why?
 - How does your answer reveal what God might be doing in your life or in the world around you?
2. Re-read the passage from John three times
 - The first time, pick out a word or phrase that stands out
 - The second time, reflect on how that word or phrase connects to your life and what it says about what God is doing in your life
 - The third time offer a prayer to God
 - Spend some time in silent reflection
3. Re-read the sermon (it's posted on our website – bethlehemdavey.org or zionithaca.org)
 - Which of the levels of meaning Pastor Kris talked about relates most to you?

Here are some other suggested readings for the coming week (if you want, try #1 or #2 above with the different passages. If your version of the Bible is hard to understand, look at some other versions on biblegateway.com. The New Revised Standard Version is what we use in worship. The Common English Bible is perhaps the best easier translation.
